<u>Adult Protective Services (APS)</u> helps prevent & protect adults from abuse, neglect & exploitation, and enhance the independence of older adults & individuals with disabilities, as well as provide financial support to low-income adults in certain long-term care settings.

<u>Child Protective Services (CPS)</u> is a continuum of specialized services designed to assist families who are unable to safely care for their children. It encompasses the identification, assessment, investigation, and treatment of abused & neglected children. CPS utilizes a differential response system to engage families to provide adequate care for their children. When circumstances require that children be removed from the home, foster care provides a safe and stable environment for children and older youth until the issues are resolved.
